The farm currently has Fuji and Golden Delicious varieties available. Other types will be ready over the next few weeks, as well as grapes, muscadines and scuppernongs.

\$20/bushel we pick or \$15/bushel u-pick

\$12/half bushel we pick or \$10/bushel u-pick

All other quantities are \$1/pound
