18-Hole Disc Golf Course Now Open

Long Creek, S.C., July 21, 2010- Chattooga Belle Farm has installed a new 18- hole disc golf course which is now open to the public. The course features views of the Blue Ridge Mountains, major elevation changes and a water hazard. The holes are placed through-out the farm and vineyard.

Chattooga Belle Farm will host the first day of the South Carolina Disc Golf Doubles State Championship on August 21st, with the final day being held in Seneca. Interested participants may register online at www.scdoubles.com.

The course is free to play until the tournament on August 21st. After that date the prices will be \$3 for a game or you may purchase an annual pass for \$25 which will allow you as many games as you would like. The farm store will be open Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and fees may be paid in the store. Fees will be on the honor system with a pay box when the farm store is not open.
